



Reggae evening in Penzance will benefit ShelterBox

The Ritz in Penzance will reverberate to the unmistakable sound of reggae roots music this Saturday as local fundraiser and promoter Pappa Guin presents a Pressure Roots Hi-fi evening in support of ShelterBox

Hoping to capture the sound of summer, and to raise funds for Cornwall's own international disaster relief agency, ShelterBox, will be Kevin McGuinness – better known locally as Pappa Guin.

Established eighteen years ago, Pressure Roots Hi-Fi '**upholds and honours traditional roots culture.**' Created and operating in Cornwall, the purpose built sound system has '**been lovingly maintained, promoted and played to bring the spiritual power of dub music to the people.**'

Pressure Roots are well known for appearing at events all over the country, as well as presenting regular nights in their home town of Falmouth. Performers have included Earl Sixteen, Nick Manasseh, Aba Shanti i, Channel One sound system, Kenny Knots, and Mungo's Hi-Fi.

The Pressure Roots sound system is becoming an active contributor to the national dub/reggae community, sustaining the traditions of sound system culture. It professionally builds speaker cabinets, and records and produces music regularly at events across the south-west.

Tickets for the event on Saturday 2 July, which runs from 10pm to 2am, cost £5, and are available in advance from Wolf Clothing in Penzance. The Ritz venue is in Queen Street.
