## TOGETHER THEY KEPT THEIR COMMUNITY FED AFTER THE FLOOD

In 2017, thousands of homes were destroyed in Peru after the hauyco – a flood of mud, debris and soil - swept through communities leaving devastation in its wake. Families lost everything; homes, livelihoods and personal items.

Yolanda was one of the many women who took up the challenge of feeding her community, pooling their resources and using ShelterBox aid to keep traumatised families from going hungry. After the disaster, many community kitchens were set up and people took it in turns to cook for the neighbourhood. Here's Yolanda with Estela, Ely and Rosmary.

She and her husband Santos also lost their home in the disaster, despite being in their sixties they rebuilt themselves.
