STUCK FOR IDEAS? DON'T WORRY

Think about your class, what they enjoy and the skills and resources you have available. We've pulled together a selection of ideas below to get your minds working. Don't be afraid to ask the kids what they would like to do.

Shine for ShelterBox

Estimate £300 - £400

Every winter, ShelterBox invites people to come together to share food and fun. Whether you hold a fundraising dinner in the hall or a picnic in the playground, you'll be changing lives with every bite.

Colour run

Estimate £500 - £1500

Run wild and make unforgettable memories by getting students, teachers and parents to wear white t-shirts and run around the school. Then get volunteers to pelt them with water-based paint at specific points on the route. Ask all participants to pay or get sponsorship to enter.

Cake sale

Estimate £40 - £100

Everyone loves a sweet treat! Ask budding bakers to bake cakes and biscuits and sell them in the canteen or playground at break time or after lunch.

Car wash

Estimate £50 - £200

Set up a car wash in your schoolyard after school or at the weekend. Make up rotas for students and have parents bring along their cars and make a donation to have them cleaned.

Non-uniform or fancy dress day

Estimate £75 - £500

Swap ties and blazers for jeans or fancy dress to raise vital funds — and ask everyone who takes part to make a donation. A simple but popular event.

Sleepover

Estimate £150 - £1,000

Take over your library, classroom or sports hall and arrange an overnight stay in school. Get everyone to bring what they would for a camping trip, including their own food and drink, and arrange games, stories and a film before bedtime. Charge a set amount per participant.
