FUNDRAISING IDEAS FOR YOUR CHURCH

First, form a core group, then think about your congregation, what they enjoy and the skills and resources you have available. We've pulled together a selection of ideas below to get your minds working.

Shine for ShelterBox

Estimate £300 - £400

Every winter, ShelterBox invites people to come together to share food and fun. Whether you hold a fundraising dinner in your church or hall, or share food in smaller groups in your own homes, you'll be changing lives with every bite. Find out more at shelterbox.org/shine

Give a tent for Lent

Estimate £385+

Estimate £100 - £500

Do you have musicians in your midst? Or a church choir? Get rehearsing and then sell tickets to a concert.

Poverty challenge

Estimate £200 - £1,000

Challenge yourselves to live below the poverty line for a set period of time. How long could you live with just £1 a day to spend on food?

Skill sale

Estimate £50- £500

There are lots of skills people will pay money for including tutoring, sewing and odd jobs. Ask for donations of skills - like an hour of gardening or baking a birthday cake - and hold an auction to sell them to the highest bidders.

Organise a games night

Estimate £50 - £500
