## SPONSORED EVENTS AT YOUR UNIVERSITY

Getting staff and students on board to complete challenges can bring your whole university together to raise funds. Here are a few ideas to get you started.

### Abseil/Skydive

**Estimate £300 - £2,000**

A high-adrenalin activity like an abseil or skydive is a popular way to encourage sponsors to dip into their pockets and will give participants the experience of a lifetime.

### Jailbreak or Lost

**Estimate £2,000 - £10,000**

Get sponsored to get as far away from your university as possible using no money at all, hitchhike in teams and test your charm with rail companies, airlines and philanthropists. Alternatively organise an event where you're dropped off somewhere unknown and have to race other teams to get back to uni – again using no money, just your wits.

### Use your unique skills

**£100 - £1,000**

If you're part of a university group like a theatre company or sports team think about how you could organise a sponsored event that uses the unique skills of your members — like a play or a tournament.

### Rally4ShelterBox

**Estimate £2,000 - £4,000**

Set up a people-powered relay around your county, map out the route and set up legs which can be completed by running, cycling, swimming, or even space-hopping. You'll need a committee to help organise everything and a support car to keep participants safe. If you're interested get in touch and we can help you set this up.

### The Three Peaks Challenge

**£1,000 - £5,000**

Depending on how many people take on this iconic challenge you could raise huge amounts. Tackling Snowdon, Ben Nevis and Scafell Pike individually is impressive, doing them together in a 24-hour time period is incredibly impressive and can show your commitment to supporting families who have lost everything.
