


THIS IS A HUMANITARIAN CRISIS

OF DISASTERS TRIGGERED BY NATURAL HAZARDS WERE CLIMATE- OR WEATHER-RELATED

Typhoons Faxai and Hagibis, Japan *September–October 2019* Affected more than 510,000 people

Cyclones Kammuri and Phanfone, Philippines *December 2019* Affected 1.9 million and 3.2 million people respectively and caused 67 deaths

Wildfires, Australia September 2019– February 2020 19.4 million hectares burned
